

ORDINANCE NO. 288

Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and Selectmen of the Town of Homer, Louisiana, in legal session convened, that the monthly rates and the charges for the consumption of electric current supplies by the Homer Light & Water Plant for commercial and residential purposes, shall be as follows;

For the first 100 K.W. 18 cents per K.W.

For the next 100 K.W. 16½ cents per K.W.

For the next 100 K.W. 16 " " K.W.

For the next 800 K.W. 14 " " K.W.

For the next 1000K.W. 13 " " K.W.

For the next 1600K.W. 11 " " K.W.

For the next 4000K.W. and all in excess thereof , 10 cents per K.W.

The minimum charge shall be \$2.00 per month.

Section 2. Be it further ordained, etc., that the power rate shall be as follows:

For the first 100 K.W. 10 cents per K.W.

For the next 100 K.W. 9 Cents per K.W.

For the next 100 K.W. 8 Cents per K.W.

For the next 100 K.W. 7 ~~2~~ cents per K.W.

For the next 100 K.W. 6 cents per K.W.

For the next 3000 K.W. and all in excess thereof, 6 cents per K.W.

The minimum charge per month shall be \$1.00 per connected horse power of 746 watts or the equivalent thereof.

Section 3. All accounts and charges for electric current shall be due and payable at the end of the following month, a discount of 25% on the above shall be allowed.

Section 4. Be it further ordained, etc., that any person, firm, or corporation, desiring electric current, shall make application for same to the Homer Light & Water Plant for service and connection.

Section 5. Be it further ordained, etc., that a meter deposit of \$5.00 be, and the same is hereby required of all consumers of electric current.

Section 6. Be it further ordained, etc., that it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to divert the flow of electric current, or to tamper with in any manner before same reaches the meter or the premises, or to in any way tamper with the wires, so that the meter will not register the true and correct amount of the current actually consumed.

Section 7. Be it further ordained, etc., that it shall be unlawful for any consumer of electric current to have his premises wired without first submitting his plans of wiring to the Superintendent of the Homer Light & Water Plant, and securing a permit therefor and it shall

further be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to change, alter or add to the wiring of his premises without first securing a permit therefor from the Superintendent of the Homer Water & Light Plant.

Section 8. Be it further ordained, etc., that where service is discontinued for nonpayment for current furnished, the amount past due must be paid in full and an extra charge of \$10.00 must be paid before service is turned on or continues again.

Section 9. Be it further ordained, etc., that any person, firm or corporation convicted of violating any of the provisions of Section 6 and 7, or either of them, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$100.00, or be imprisoned in the Town Prison for not more than thirty days, or both, in the discretion of the Mayor.

Section 10. Be it further ordained, etc., that all ordinances inconsistent or in conflict herewith, be, and the same are hereby repealed, and particularly is ordinance No. 165 of the Town of Homer hereby repealed.

Section 11. Be it further ordained, etc., that this ordinance shall become effective and operative from and after its promulgation.
