An Ordinance to provide for participation by the Town of Homer in an Interlocal Risk Management Agency formed to share the risk and administration of accident and health protection; and to authorize the Mayor to expend specific funds to the Town of Homer to contribute to the group self insurance fund of such Agency.

WHEREAS, the Town of Homer now provides or desires to provide accident and health coverage or protection for its employees;

WHEREAS, Louisiana Revised Statutes 33:1338-1347, as amended, authorizes two (2) or more municipalities to establish and Interlocal Risk Management Agency with respect to risk sharing; and

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Municipal Risk Management Agency II has been created by an agreement between two (2) or more Municipalities adopted pursuant to Louisiana Revised Statutes 33:1338-1347, as amended;

WHEREAS, it is desirable for the Town of Homer to join the Louisiana Municipal Risk Management Agency II and participate in its group self insurance fund in order to more efficiently provide a method of risk sharing for accident and health coverage or protection in the administration of claims for its employees;

NOW, THEREFORE: BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Town of Homer join the Louisiana Municipal Risk Management Agency II and expend the sum of \$60,000.00 as its contribution to the group self insurance fund for accident and health risk sharing maintained or to be established by the Louisiana Municipal Risk Management Agency II.
