The following Ordinance was introduced by the Mayor and Council:

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND ENACTING A FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF HOMER, LOUISIANA, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 1983, AND ENDING JUNE 30, 1984.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Selectmen of the Town of Homer, Claiborne Parish, Louisiana, that:

SECTION 1. The attached detailed estimate of revenues for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1983, and ending June 30, 1984, hereinafter referred to as fiscal year 1984, be and the same is hereby adopted and enacted to serve as a Federal Revenue Budget for the Town of Homer, Louisiana, during the aforementioned period of time.

SECTION 2. The attached detailed estimate of Expenditures by function and department for fiscal year 1984, be and the same is hereby adopted and enacted to serve as a Federal Revenue Sharing Budget for the Town of Homer, Louisiana, during the aforementioned period of time.

SECTION 3. The amounts contained in the expenditures portion of said Federal Revenue Sharing Budget is hereby ordained and declared to serve as the official appropriation of funds for the various departments of the Town of Homer for the fiscal year 1984.

SECTION 4. The amounts contained in the Federal Revenue Sharing Budget for fiscal year 1984 are available for actual expenditure only to the extent as set forth in the Federal Revenue Sharing Budget for the fiscal year 1984.

SECTION 5. All Ordinances, resolutions, and orders in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
