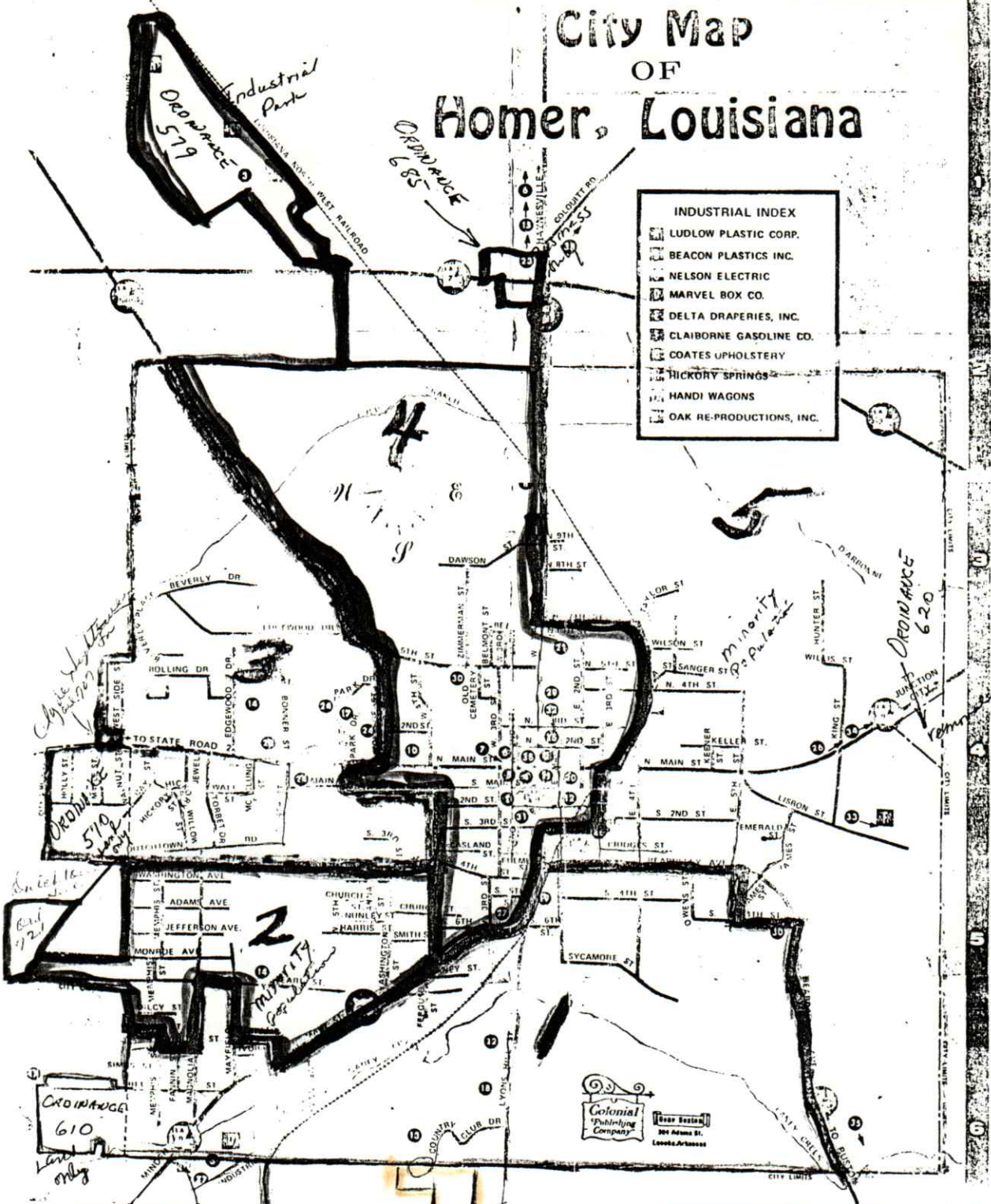

Homer, the parish seat of Claiborne Parish, was named for the Greek post and was laid out around the courthouse square in 1850 by Frank Vaughn. Homer enjoys an excellent location for trade of all types: only 50 miles from Shreveport, and within 300 miles of Dallas, Houston, New Orleans and Memphis. Our climate allows outdoor activities 12 months a year with an average yearly temperature of 66 degrees. Excellent family life, education, churches and increased industrial activity are the keystones of the town.

Homer's modern 57 bed hospital provides the best in medical care for the people of the town. There are two up-to-date clinics with complete facilities for all types of diagnostic and out patient care. A private nursing home with facilities for 75 provides for the care of the elderly. There is also a 24-hour ambulance service.

Oil and gas wells seem to sprout from the fields near Homer as Claiborne Parish has 1176 producing oil wells and 200 producing gas wells. One of the largest deposits of ore lies in Claiborne Parish. There is a sizable bentonite deposit near Homer.

A ready labor supply, adequate transportation and abundant water (62,000,000 gal. per day from Lake Claiborne) is available. Homer is on the move industrially. A national concern supplies polychlorinated chemical and other synthetic products.
