

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE
SALE OF THREE COMPACTOR GARBAGE
TRUCKS NO LONGER NEEDED BY
THE TOWN OF HOMER

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Selectmen of the Town of
Homer, Louisiana:

SECTION 1. Since the Town of Homer has entered into a
contract with a private contractor for garbage collection, the
following compactor garbage trucks belonging to the Town of
Homer are no longer needed and may be sold:

- A. One 1981 Ford F600 cab and chassis
truck with a Leach compactor
- B. One 1982 Ford F600 cab and chassis
truck with a Leach compactor
- C. One 1983 Ford F700 cab and chassis
truck with a Peabody compactor

SECTION 2. Bids will be accepted at the Mayor's office
until 1:30 P.M., May 26, 1986 for the purchase of the above
described trucks under terms and conditions established by the
Mayor on file in his office, the right to reject all bids being
reserved.

SECTION 3. All bids must be for cash and the minimum price
for each truck shall be \$ 15,000.00 for Item A., \$ 15,000.00
for Item B., and \$ 15,000.00 for Item C, provided that if all
three trucks are not sold all bids may be rejected.

The foregoing ordinance was read, considered, and is adopted this
fifth day of May, 1986.
