

ORDINANCE NO. 745

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SURPLUS
EQUIPMENT NO LONGER NEEDED BY THE TOWN OF HOMER

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Selectmen of the Town of Homer, Louisiana:

Section 1. Since the Town has displaced old equipment with new, the following equipment belonging to the Town of Homer is no longer needed and may be sold:


1. One 1982 Chevrolet Impala - VIN 2G1AL69L3C1177090
2. One 1976 Ford F-600 with flatbed that dumps - VIN F61BVC01275
3. One 1973 Ford F-600 with flatbed that dumps - VIN F60DVS40167
4. One 1973 Chevrolet gravel truck - VIN CCE613V145229
5. One 1972 Ford gravel truck - VIN F61CVN00964
6. One 1979 John Deere 750 dozier engine
7. One 250 cu. in. 6 cylinder Chevrolet engine rigged for fogging
8. One Yeager cement mixer
9. One sickle mower attachment - some parts missing
10. One wrecked 1965 Ford F-600 truck - VIN F60AK613069
11. One 17 cu. yd. Leach garbage compactor

Equipment may be viewed upon request through City Hall.

Section 2. Sealed bids will be accepted at the Mayor's office until 1:30 P. M., December 1, 1986 for the purchase of the above-described equipment. The right to reject any or all bids is reserved.

Section 3. All bids must be for cash, money order, or cashier's check. Except for item #1 above, whose minimum price will be \$600.00, the highest bid for each item will prevail.
