## ORDINANCE NO. 745

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SURPLUS EQUIPMENT NO LONGER NEEDED BY THE TOWN OF HOMER

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Selectmen of the Town of Homer, Louisiana:
