

The following Ordinance was introduced by Selectman Robert Glenn

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND ENACTING AN OPERATING  
BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF HOMER, LOUISIANA, FOR  
THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING July 1, 1986 AND  
ENDING June 30, 1987 :

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Selectmen of the Town of  
Homer, Claiborne Parish, Louisiana, that:

SECTION 1. The attached detailed estimate of Revenues for the fiscal  
year beginning July 1, 1986 and ending June 30, 1987,  
hereinafter referred to as fiscal year 86/87, be and the same is hereby  
adopted and enacted to serve as an overall Operating Budget for the Town  
of Homer, Louisiana, during the aforementioned period of time.

SECTION 2. The attached detailed estimate of Expenditures by function  
and department for fiscal year 86/87, be and the same is hereby adopted and  
enacted to serve as an overall Operating Budget for the Town of Homer, Lou-  
isiana, during the aforementioned period of time.

SECTION 3. The amounts contained in the expenditures portion of said  
Operating Budget is hereby ordained and declared to serve as the official  
appropriation of funds for the various departments of the Town of Homer for  
the fiscal year 86/87.

SECTION 4. The amounts contained in the Operating Budget for the  
fiscal year 86/87 are available for actual expenditure only to the ex-  
tent as set forth in the Operating Budget for fiscal year 86/87.

SECTION 5. All ordinances, resolutions, and orders in conflict  
herewith are hereby repealed.
