

The following ordinance was offered by Susan Herring
 and seconded by Dale Foster :

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 15 OF THE CHARTER OF
 THE TOWN OF HOMER, LOUISIANA, TO PROVIDE THAT
 THE MARSHAL SHALL BE ELECTED FOR A TERM OF
 FOUR (4) YEARS AND SHALL RESIDE AND BE
 DOMICILED WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS

SECTION I. BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Selectmen of the Town of Homer, Louisiana, in Regular Session convened on the 4th day of November, 1996, that the charter of the Town of Homer, Louisiana, be amended, pursuant to the provisions of Louisiana Revised Statutes 33:1181, as follows:

SECTION II. Section 15 of the municipal charter of the Town of Homer, Louisiana, is hereby amended and restated to read as follows:

"Section 15. Marshal to be elected; residence and term of office of marshal.

No. 1. There shall be one (1) marshal for the Town of Homer, who shall be chief of police. The marshal shall be elected by the qualified voters of said corporation to serve a term of office of four (4) years.

2nd. To be eligible for election to and to continue in the office of marshal, an individual must reside and be domiciled within the corporate limits of the Town of Homer."

The above ordinance was read and discussed by Section and as a whole, and a vote was taken thereon as follows:
