At a regular session of the Mayor and Selectmen of the Town of Homer, Louisiana, held on Monday, November 1, 1999, the following ordinance was offered by <u>Joseph Merritt</u> and seconded by <u>Scott Roberson</u>:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION IV OF ORDINANCE NO. 815 OF 1996 TO PROVIDE FOR THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE MAYOR AND SELECTMEN OF THE TOWN OF HOMER, LOUISIANA, IN THE EMPLOYMENT OF AN ADMINISTRATOR OR CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF HOMER MEMORIAL HOSPITAL

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Selectmen of the Town of Homer, Louisiana, in Regular Session convened on the 1st day of November, 1999, that Section IV of Ordinance No. 815 of 1996 of the Town of Homer, Louisiana, be amended to read as follows:

"SECTION IV. The Board of Directors shall be responsible for employing and discharging all hospital personnel, establishing bylaws, rules and regulations relating to the admittance of patients, establishing charges for services rendered by the hospital, collecting accounts and any and all other duties and responsibilities that normally apply to the various board of directors of comparable hospitals within the State of Louisiana, except that, with regard to the employing of the administrator or chief executive officer of the hospital, the Board of Directors shall present a nominee and employment proposal to the Mayor and Selectmen of the Town of Homer for their advice and consent, and said nominee shall be employed and said employment proposal shall be adopted only upon a majority vote of the Selectmen of the Town of Homer.

All by-laws, rules and regulations and all amendments and supplements thereto formulated by the Board of Directors shall first be submitted to and approved by the Mayor and Selectmen of the Town of Homer."

The above ordinance was read and discussed by Section and as a whole, and a vote was taken thereon as follows:
