

ORDINANCE NO. 840

The following Ordinance was introduced by Selectman Scott Roberson
and seconded by Joseph Merritt.

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING AND ENACTING AN
OPERATING BUDGET FOR THE TOWN OF HOMER,
LOUISIANA, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING
July 1, 2000 AND ENDING June 30, 2001.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Selectmen of the Town of Homer,
Claiborne Parish, Louisiana, that:

SECTION I. The attached detailed estimate of Revenues and Expenditures for the
fiscal year beginning July 1, 2000, and ending June 30, 2001, hereinafter referred
to as fiscal year 2001, be and the same is hereby adopted and enacted to serve as an
overall Operating Budget for the Town of Homer, Louisiana, during the aforementioned
period of time.

SECTION II. The amounts contained in this Operating Budget is hereby ordained and
declared to serve as the official appropriation of funds for the various departments of the
Town of Homer.

SECTION III. The amounts contained in the Operating Budget are available for actual
only to the extent as set forth in this Operating Budget for the fiscal year.

SECTION IV. All ordinances, resolutions, and orders in conflict herewith are hereby
repealed.
