

**Town of Homer
Ordinance No. 09- 110**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF HOMER ADOPTING
THE PROPOSED OPERATING BUDGET FOR YEAR 2010
JANUARY 1, 2010 – DECEMBER 31, 2010**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF SELECTMAN OF THE
TOWN OF HOMER, CLAIBORNE PARISH, LOUISIANA THAT:**

- Section I:** The attached detailed estimate of Revenues and Expenditures for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2010 and ending December 31, 2010, hereinafter referred to as fiscal year 2010, be and the same is hereby adopted and enacted to serve as an overall Operating Budget for the Town of Homer, Louisiana, during the aforementioned period of time.
- Section II:** The amounts contained in this Operating Budget is hereby ordained and declared to serve as the official appropriations of funds for all of the departments of the Town of Homer.
- Section III:** The amounts contained in the Operating Budget are available for actual expenses only to the extent as set forth in this Operating Budget for the fiscal year 2010.
- Section IV:** All ordinances, resolutions, and orders in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that if any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions herein which can be given effect without the invalid provision and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable.

This ordinance having been submitted in writing, having been read by title and adopted at a public meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Homer, State of Louisiana, was then submitted to an official vote as a whole, the vote thereon being as follows.
